Fepio / Vaping

Rydym fel staff yn bryderus iawn am y cynnydd cenedlaethol o bobl ifanc sy'n fepio. Mae ystadegau diweddaraf yn awgrymu bod 16% o bobl ifanc rhwng 11 ac 17 yn y Deyrnas Unedig wedi ceisio fepio. Mae fepio yn anghyfreithlon i rai dan 18 oed ac mae'r fêps ffug sy'n cael eu gwerthu hefyd ar gynnydd. Tra nad oes ymchwil cadarn am effaith hirdymor fepio, mae rhai adroddiadau yn awgrymu bod hyd at 60 o gemegion mewn fêp, a'r rheini yn medru cael effaith negyddol ar gyrrf bobl ifanc.

Nid yw fepio nac ysmigu yn gyfreithlon ar dir yr ysgol, boed y tu mewn neu'r tu allan i'r adeilad. Mae modd dirwyo unrhyw un sy'n euog o wneud hyd at £100.

Rydym yn eich annog fel rhieni a gofalwyr i gymryd cipolwg ar rai o symptomau fepio, ac i drafod peryglon posib y fath weithred efo'ch plentyn. Byddwch yn effro i'r mathau o fideos mae eich plentyn yn gwyllo ar TikTok neu apiau tebyg, gan fod nifer o fideos yn cyfareddu fepio. Os oes gennych amheuon bod eich plentyn yn fepio'n anghyfreithlon, gallwch gysylltu â'r ysgol am gymorth gan asiantaethau allanol.



We as staff are becoming increasingly concerned with the national increase in young people who are vaping. The latest statistics suggest that 16% of 11-17 year olds in the UK have tried vaping. Vaping is illegal to under 18 year olds and counterfeit vapes are a growing concern to Trading Standards, who report an increase in the sales of such items. Whilst there is little evidence of the long term effect of vaping, some reports state there are up to 60 chemicals in a vape that can negatively affect the bodies of young people.

Both vaping and smoking are illegal on school grounds, whether inside or outside the building. A possible fine of £100 can be issued to anyone found guilty of using vapes or cigarettes in school grounds.

We encourage you as parents and carers to look at some of the signs your child might be vaping and to discuss with them the dangers of using vapes at such a young age. Be alert to what your child is viewing on TikTok and similar apps, as videos can glamourize vaping. Should you have any concerns that your child is vaping, you can contact the school who can put you in touch with external agencies who will be able to help.
