Beth fydd y cymhwyster yn ei gynnwys?

Mae'r TGAU hwn yn gofyn i ddysgwyr i ddeall egwyddorion datblygiad dynol, iechyd a llesiant, a sut mae'r sectorau iechyd, gofal cymdeithasol a gofal plant yn cefnogi ac yn ac yn hybu'r datblygiad hwnnw. Mae'n gwrs difyr a diddorol, ac yn addas i unrhyw un sy'n ystyried gyrfa o fewn y sectorau perthnasol. Bydd 60% o'r cymhwyster yn waith cwrs di-arholiad, gyda'r 40% arall yn cael ei asesu fel arholiad ysgrifenedig ym mlwyddyn 10.

UNED 1:

Yn yr uned hon, bydd dysgwyr yn dysgu am iechyd, gofal cymdeithasol a gofal plant yn yr 21ain ganrif, gyda ffocws ar ddatblygiad corfforol, deallusol, iaith, emosiynol a chymdeithasol. Bydd dysgwyr hefyd yn meithrin gwybodaeth a dealltwriaeth o'r deddfwriaeth allweddol sy'n sail i iechyd a gofal yng Nghymru.

Arholiad 1 awr 30 munud - **40%** o'r cymhwyster.

UNED 2:

Mae'r asesiad di-arholiad hwn yn ffocysu ar y mathau o ofal fydd efallai angen ar oedolion, y cyflyrau a mathau o salwch all effeithio oedolion, sut mae hybu iechyd ymysg oedolion, a sut mae pobl broffesiynol yn gweithio i gwrdd ag anghenion iechyd a gofal oedolion. Caiff y gwaith ei gwblhau ar ffurf prosiect digidol fydd werth **30%** o'r cymhwyster.

UNED 3:

Mae'r asesiad di-arholiad hwn yn ffocysu ar gerrig milltir disgwylidiedig plant, y cyflyrau a mathau o salwch all effeithio plant, y gwahanol mathau o ofal plant sydd (yn ddibynnol ar anghenion y plentyn), a sut mae pobl broffesiynol yn cwrdd ag anghenion penodol plant. Caiff y gwaith ei gwblhau ar ffurf prosiect digidol fydd werth **30%** o'r cymhwyster.

Syllabus

What will the qualification cover? This GCSE requires learners to understand the principles of human development, health and well-being, and how the health, social care and childcare sectors support and promote this development. It is an engaging and interesting course, suitable for anyone considering a career within the relevant sectors. 60% of the qualification will be non-exam coursework, with the remaining 40% assessed as a written examination in year 10.

UNIT 1:

In this unit, learners will learn about health, social care and childcare in the 21st century, with a focus on physical, intellectual, language, emotional and social development. Learners will also acquire knowledge and understanding of the key legislation that underpins the health and care sectors in Wales.

Exam 1 hour 30 minutes - **40%** of the qualification.

UNIT 2:

This non-examination assessment focuses on the types of care that adults may need, the conditions and illnesses adults may experience, how to promote health among adults, and how professionals work to meet the health and care needs of adults. The work will be completed in the form of a digital project which will be worth **30%** of the qualification.

UNIT 3:

This non-examination assessment focuses on children's expected milestones, the conditions and types of illness that can affect children, the different types of childcare that exist (depending on the child's needs), and how professionals meet children's specific needs. The work will be completed in the form of a digital project which will be worth **30%** of the qualification.
